OUTSIDE: RECESS	-Keep body & belongings to self -Care for school property and the property of others -Sit down to eat	-Use positive and appropriate language with others -Include others in play -Pick up trash	-Go directly to play areas and remain outside gates -Take a knee at the bell; at the whistle, walk to line up at numbers -Place balls in bin -Bring in what you take out -Tell the yard duty if there is an injury	-Respect nature -Respond, listen, and follow directions of adult supervisors -Solve disagreements over games with "rock, paper, scissors" -Seek and accept help from peacekeepers	
OUTSIDE: BIG TOY	-Walk on tan bark -Tan bark stays on the ground -Balls belong only on blacktop and field -No running, wrestling, or horseplay, or tag on the structure -Do not sit on top of monkey bars or play structure -Both hands need to be on uneven bars at all times -Slide down the slides on bottom, feet first and one at a time				
OUTSIDE: BLACK TOP	-No playing behind the two sheds -Follow "Tuffli rules" for recess games unless the rules are agreed upon beforehand -Tag or chase is only appropriate if all students involved want to play -Keep balls away from fences and classrooms				
OUTSIDE: SWINGS	-Count 40 forward swings and get off so someone else can have a turn -Wait patiently in one line for a turn on the swings -No "counting" on others it is the responsibility of the person swinging to count 40 swings and get off -Use swings for forward swinging only: No jumping off swings, flipping backwards, or twisting swing				
OUTSIDE: FIELD	-Stay in view of yard duty -Play by the rules of the game - soccer, football, kickball, etcBe considerate of P.E. classes -Keep off fences, soccer goals, baseball backstops, and trees -No throwing items over fences -Touch football only
