COMMON AREAS: HALLS/QUAD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use walking feet in line and getting to the line Keep body & belongings to yourself - keep enough space between people -Face forward 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Pick up trash you may find -Place belongings on hooks (even if it's not yours) -Use kind words and actions -Use appropriate voice level 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Walk directly from one place to another (no detours) -Follow the line -Walk your wheels -Line up quickly and quietly -Hold all personal items; don't touch bags on hooks -Hang bags (zipped up!) and jackets on hooks 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Quiet/no voice -No cutting -Wait patiently for teacher- hands and feet to self
COMMON AREAS: LINING UP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Get in line behind the last person- no cuts -Stay to the right -Keep voices low so others can learn and listen -Wait to be invited into the classroom -Line up on classroom number after the whistle 			
BATHROOM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use walking feet -Keep body & belongings to self 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Give peers privacy -Use appropriate language -Enter and exit from stalls correctly. Lock and unlock doors with each use 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Flush toilet -Wash hands with soap -Keep water in sink -Throw paper towels in trash -No games or horseplay -Return to class promptly -Follow classroom rules for leaving classroom 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Wait turn -Quiet voice

LUNCHROOM/ MPR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use walking feet -Keep body & belongings to yourself -Sit quietly or line up to buy -Focus on eating before talking -No throwing food -Raise your hand with questions or to ask permission -Stay seated to eat until excused 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Include others -Help monitors clean up the table with the cloth and broom -Use positive and appropriate language 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Clean up after yourself -When excused, place garbage, compostables, and recyclables in the correct container -No games or horseplay -WALK directly to playground for recess -Push carts safely 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Eat your own food only -Use indoor voice -Respond immediately to adults on duty -Walk
CLASSROOM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use walking feet -Keep body & belongings to yourself -Use inside voices -Share time on technology with classmates -Only use tools or websites when you have permission 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use positive and appropriate language with others in person and online -Be a team player! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Respect classroom materials, furniture, and technology -Keep things from home (cellphones, electronic devices, and toys) in backpacks -Ask a teacher or adult if you find something inappropriate online (do not draw attention to other students) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Listen and follow direction of teacher and other adults in the room -Take turns talking and actively listen to others -Respect the property of others -Do not share personal information or use inappropriate language online

OUTSIDE: RECESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Keep body & belongings to self -Care for school property and the property of others -Sit down to eat 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use positive and appropriate language with others -Include others in play -Pick up trash 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Go directly to play areas and remain outside gates -Take a knee at the bell; at the whistle, walk to line up at numbers -Place balls in bin -Bring in what you take out -Tell the yard duty if there is an injury 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Respect nature -Respond, listen, and follow directions of adult supervisors -Solve disagreements over games with “rock, paper, scissors” -Seek and accept help from peacekeepers
OUTSIDE: BIG TOY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Walk on tan bark -Tan bark stays on the ground -Balls belong only on blacktop and field -No running, wrestling, or horseplay, or tag on the structure -Do not sit on top of monkey bars or play structure -Both hands need to be on uneven bars at all times -Slide down the slides on bottom, feet first and one at a time 			
OUTSIDE: BLACK TOP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -No playing behind the two sheds -Follow “Tuffli rules” for recess games unless the rules are agreed upon beforehand -Tag or chase is only appropriate if all students involved want to play -Keep balls away from fences and classrooms 			
OUTSIDE: SWINGS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Count 40 forward swings and get off so someone else can have a turn -Wait patiently in one line for a turn on the swings -No “counting” on others - - it is the responsibility of the person swinging to count 40 swings and get off -Use swings for forward swinging only: No jumping off swings, flipping backwards, or twisting swing 			
OUTSIDE: FIELD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Stay in view of yard duty -Play by the rules of the game - soccer, football, kickball, etc. -Be considerate of P.E. classes -Keep off fences, soccer goals, baseball backstops, and trees -No throwing items over fences -Touch football only
